

V. CONCLUSIONS AND IMPLICATIONS

A. Conclusions

Based on the results of research that has been carried out related to determinants of demand for chicken eggs in Limpakuwus, Sumbang, the following conclusions can be drawn:

1. The variables of household income and the number of family dependents had a significant positive effect on the demand for chicken eggs in Limpakuwus, while the price of chicken eggs, price of chicken meats, and the education of household head did not have a significant effect on the demand for chicken eggs in Limpakuwus.
2. The variable that most influences the demand for chicken eggs in Limpakuwus is household income.

B. Implication

Household income, and the number of family dependents have a positive effect on the demand for chicken eggs in Limpakuwus Village. Thus, to be able to meet the needs of household consumption, Limpakuwus Village must increase the level of its household income through the agricultural sector and other sectors outside of agriculture.

C. Research Limitations

This study used a sample of 95 households in Limpakuwus. It is hoped that the next research can reach a wider range of households so as to get better research results. In addition, the results in the study indicated the

presence of other variables outside the model that have a strong suspicion in influencing the demand for chicken eggs, such as the price of duck eggs, and others.
