## **CHAPTER V CONCLUSION**

## A. Conclusion

Based on the research entitled "The Association Between Disaster Preparedness Training and The Preparedness Behavior of The KSR PMI Unit of Universitas Jenderal Soedirman", it can be concluded:

- 1. The majority of research respondents were female and aged the average age of the respondents was 21 years, and the majority had attended disaster preparedness training
- 2. Respondents who have preparedness behavior in the high category are 86.2%, while respondents who are in the low category are 13.8%.
- 3. There is a relationship between disaster preparedness training and the preparedness behavior of KSR PMI Unit members of Universitas Jenderal Soedirman.

## B. Research Suggestion

1. For Educational Institutions

This research is expected to be used as a reference in providing lecture material on the importance of disaster preparedness training in emergency nursing courses.

2. For Respondents

It is recommended that respondents can increase their knowledge about disaster preparedness behavior through participation in training programs or counselling on disaster preparedness both held by internal KSR and from external parties and increase literacy about disaster prevention.

3. For Further Researchers

If future researchers conduct the same research, they can take samples in different places and with a broader range or examine other factors that influence preparedness behavior, such as knowledge and attitudes about disaster risk.
