## V. CONCLUSION AND IMPLICATION

## A. Conclusion

Based on the results of the discussion of the influence of the number of TKI and GDP, several conclusions can be drawn, namely:

- 1. The number of Indonesian migrant workers positive and significant affected remittances in Indonesia 2007-2022.
- 2. GDP did not affect remittances in Indonesia 2007-2022.

## **B.** Implication

From the results of the research analysis and conclusions that have been submitted. The variable number of Indonesian migrant workers significant positive affects the variable remittances in Indonesia 2007-2022. This shows that the Government should pay more attention to and increase the number of migrant workers. Governments can provide education and training programs that prepare prospective migrant workers with the skills needed in the global job market. The choice of placement country can also determine the welfare of Indonesian migrant workers. And the government must also ensure the protection and guarantee of the rights of migrant workers while working abroad. With the increase in the number of Indonesian migrant workers, remittances will also increase. Remittances received can positively impact consumption and investment in the country of origin. In addition, some remittances can also be invested in businesses or property in the country of origin, which can promote long-term economic growth.

## C. Research Limitation

This research can be used as a reference for the same research topic. Because this research still has limitations, such as data. Future researchers should be able to add research variables to be studied and more periods to obtain better research results.
