CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

This chapter contains of suggestions and conclusions. The research's conclusions are based from the findings and discussion. Once the conclusions have been reached, the researcher proposes suggestions that are relevant to the findings.

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the research conducted through interviews with students in XI MIPA 6 SMA N 5 Purwokerto, there are some conclusions that can answer the research questions and objectives. The research questions are: how is the implementation, what are the students' perceptions, and what are the advantages and disadvantages of online learning during the pandemic at SMA N 5 Purwokerto?

The implementation of online learning was not effective. The implementation was bad because the teachers and the students are demanded to understand the technology and application that day. The main factors also came from internet connection or internet data and self-study. The student's perception of offline learning was better than online learning. Students also believe that online learning has positively affected their academic scores. For the disadvantages were connection and adequate devices the main problem for the implementation, because a slow internet connection and old devices can prevent the learning process. For the advantages made students' academic grades were good and online learning helped students during pandemic, because it was the only method to gain education.

5.2 Suggestion

The researcher proposes some suggestions to the English teacher and other researchers:

a. For English Teachers

- Provide support to students who may find it challenging to adapt to online learning. This can be done by offering additional guidance or resources, such as tutorials or counseling services.
- Seek feedback from students regularly to enhance the learning experience.
 This can be done through surveys or feedback sessions to identify areas for improvement and adjust teaching strategies accordingly.
- 3. Encourage peer-to-peer interaction among students to promote a sense of community and support. This can be done by providing opportunities for group work or online discussions.

b. For Other Researchers

- 1. Investigate the strategies and techniques used by teachers to engage students and make online learning more effective.
- 2. Investigate the challenges faced by teachers in the implementation of online learning and identify ways to address these challenges.
- 3. Conduct a comparative study on the effectiveness of online learning versus offline learning, taking into account factors such as student engagement, academic performance, and social interaction.
