

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATION

This chapter contains the conclusion and recommendations based on the findings as shown in the data analysis.

#### 5.1. Conclusion

Based on the findings, it can be concluded that Aladeen has the characteristics of a personalist dictator. These characteristics are one-man rule, winning coalition and informal rule. The first characteristic of a personalist dictator is one-man rule which in the film is shown by Aladeen having the extreme freedom to rule his country, dominate the military power, and the state apparatus.
