CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusions

Based on the analysis of the utterances of Jerry Seinfeld's Stand-up Comedy special show "23 Hours to Kill" on Netflix about figures of speech, there are some conclusions:

- 1. There are 6 types of figures of speech applied in the utterances of "Jerry Seinfeld's Stand-up Comedy special show "23 Hours to Kill" material on Netflix". They are 16 data of overstatement, 10 data of simile,5 data of metaphor, 3 data of personification, 1 datum of understatement, and 1 datum of verbal irony. Based on the data, it shows that the most figures of speech used in his stand-up comedy material is overstatement which consists of 16 data. On the other hand, the least types of figures of speech used in this Seinfeld's special show was understatement and verbal irony with only 1 datum. The first research question of this research already answered in the analysis above.
- 2. It is revealed that there are 4 functions of figures of speech. The researcher found all 4 functions of figures of speech, there are to afford imaginative pleasure with 27 data, to say much in brief compass with 7 data, to add emotional intensity with 4 data, and to bring and additional imagery with 1 datum,. The data

above shows that to afford the imaginative pleasure becomes the most used function by Seinfeld with 27 (69,23%) data and to bring an additional imagery with 1 (2,56%) datum becomes the least.

From the data the researcher concludes that most of Seinfeld's special show "23 Hours to Kill" material is consist of playing with people imagination and exaggerating the situations/something to make people laugh and also enjoy the jokes that relate to them. Furthemore, each of figures of speech and its function can be combined with one another to create laughter in stand-up comedy. The use of figures of speech is important in stand-up comedy because with the proper used of figures of speech it made Seinfeld's materials/jokes attract the audience's attention so they can enjoy the show more as well as get the message contained in every jokes.

5.2 Suggestions

Based on the analysis of the utterances of Jerry Seinfeld's stand-up comedy special show about the types and functions of figures of speech, there are some suggestions:

1. For all those who read this thesis, especially English Department students, the students hope to be able to understand and expand their knowledge of figures of speech, especially in the

- discussion of the types and functions of figures of speech in the stylistic analysis field.
- 2. For future researchers who want to do the same research, they can take different objects to study such as movies, songs, poems or nother sources. It is recommended to compile materials and more complete analysis because even in this study there are still many shortcomings. This research also contributes to the reader and can be used as a reference for linguistic studies.
- 3. For English lecturers, the author hopes that they can make this thesis one of the materials related to figures of speech that focuses onthe types and functions analysis.
