

## ABSTRAK

### **Perkembangan Hubungan Pertemanan Antarmahasiswa Magang Merdeka Melalui *Self-disclosure* di Era *Post COVID-19* (Studi Kasus Divisi Jurnalistik Badan Penyelenggara Jaminan Produk Halal Kementerian Agama Republik Indonesia)**

Penelitian membahas perkembangan hubungan pertemanan antarmahasiswa magang merdeka divisi jurnalistik BPJPH *batch 3* melalui *self-disclosure* di era *post COVID-19*. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui bagaimana perkembangan hubungan pertemanan antarmahasiswa magang merdeka divisi jurnalistik BPJPH *batch 3* melalui *self-disclosure* di era *post COVID-19*. Serta untuk mengetahui faktor yang mempengaruhi dan menghambat perkembangan hubungan pertemanan tersebut. Teori penetrasi sosial Altman dan Taylor digunakan sebagai pisau analisis proses perkembangan hubungan antarmahasiswa magang divisi jurnalistik BPJPH *batch 3*. Penelitian ini menggunakan metode kualitatif deskriptif dan pengumpulan data dengan wawancara. Informan dalam penelitian ini dipilih menggunakan teknik *purposive sampling* agar data yang didapatkan bisa lebih sesuai. Hasil penelitian, menunjukkan bahwa perkembangan pertemanan mahasiswa magang jurnalistik BPJPH *batch 3* menjadi intim dan dekat. Proses perkembangan hubungan pertemanan ini, berjalan lancar melalui semua tahapan pada teori penetrasi sosial kecuali depenetrasi. Hal tersebut, didukung oleh faktor senasib sepenanggungan yang mengharuskan terus bekerja sama satu dengan lain, satu frekuensi, seringnya intensitas bersama saat bekerja, lingkungan yang suportif, nuansa kantor yang diwarnai humor-humor candaan, dan fasilitas di ruangan kerja divisi jurnalistik yang sangat memadai. Selain itu, ditemukan banyak persamaan seperti umur, latar belakang jurusan dan angkatan, ketertarikan terhadap sesuatu, hingga adanya kesamaan kepribadian dan kebiasaan. Faktor penghambat muncul ketika awal perkenalan yang mengharuskan mereka beradaptasi di lingkungan baru.

## ***ABSTRACT***

### **The Development of Friendship Relations among Independent Internship Students Through Self-disclosure in the Post COVID-19 Era (Case Study of the Journalistic Division of the Halal Product Assurance Organizing Agency of the Ministry of Religion of the Republic of Indonesia)**

The study discusses the development of friendly relations between independent apprentice students in the journalistic division of BPJPH batch 3 through self-disclosure in the post COVID-19 era. This study aims to find out how the development of friendly relations between independent apprentice students in the journalistic division of BPJPH batch 3 through self-disclosure in the post COVID-19 era. As well as to find out the factors that influence and hinder the development of the friendly relationship. Altman and Taylor's social penetration theory was used as a tool for analyzing the process of developing relations between intern students in the journalism division of BPJPH batch 3. This study used a descriptive qualitative method and collected data by interview. Informants in this study were selected using a purposive sampling technique so that the data obtained could be more appropriate. The results of the study showed that the friendly relations development of BPJPH batch 3 journalistic internship students became intimate and close. The process of developing this friendship relationship runs smoothly through all the stages in the theory of social penetration except depenetration. This is supported by the shared destiny that requires continuing to work with one another, the frequency, often the intensity together when working, a supportive environment, an office atmosphere filled with humor and jokes, and facilities in the journalism division's workspace which are very adequate. In addition, many similarities were found, such as age, major and class background, interest in something, to the fact that there are similarities in personality and habits. The inhibiting factor appears when the initial introduction requires them to adapt in a new environment.
