CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

This chapter presents the conclusions from the data analysis. Besides, the researcher also adds some suggestions related to this research result to enrich the insight of this research.

5.1 Conclusions

Based on the research results and discussions, the conclusions were drawn as follows:

- 1. The most commonly problems faced by the grade 9D students at SMP Negeri 1 Gumelar in reading comprehension on narrative are: language knowledge (80%), followed by reading process (76%), background knowledge (74%), reading strategies (70%), and the last problems is motivation (58%).
- 2. The major factors that cause the problems faced by the grade 9D students at SMP Negeri 1 Gumelar in reading comprehension on narrative texts are: information processing (81%), followed by less familiarity with the subject matter (78%), text difficulty (74%), poor fluency (67%), and the last is lack of vocabulary (60%).
- 3. How the grade 9D students at SMP Negeri 1 Gumelar overcome problems in reading comprehension on narrative texts are: reading slowly and carefully (81%), followed by pausing the texts (81%), use a dictionary (77%), note-taking (66%), and underlining or circling important information (62%).

5.2 Suggestions

Based on the result of research which the researcher conducted related to the problems, factors, and how do the students overcome problems in reading comprehension on narrative texts at SMP Negeri 1 Gumelar in the academic year of 2022/2023, the researcher then proposes some suggestions.

1. For English Teachers

From the result of this research, English teachers are expected to be able to create an interesting learning environment to increase students' motivation in reading comprehension on narrative text, and to create creative activities to help students enrich their vocabularies.

2. For students

From the result of this research, students are expected to enrich their vocabularies in order to decrease unfamiliar vocabularies that will be found in reading comprehension on narrative text.

3. For Other Researchers

The result of this research is expected to make a positive contribution and give information to other researchers when they are conducting the same research, and hopefully, through this research, the researchers will get motivation to increase their own ability at comprehending text.
