## CHAPTER V CLOSING

## A. Conclusions

Based on the research results, the following conclusions can be drawn:

- Students' legal aspirations toward the rules prohibiting sexual violence on the Faculty of Law Campus of Jenderal Soedirman University are moderate. This can be proven by:
  - a. Moderate level of prevention of sexual violence on campus;
  - b. Moderate level of handling of victims of sexual violence on campus;
  - c. Less good level of mechanism for handling sexual violence on campus;
  - d. Moderate level of sanctions for perpetrators of sexual violence on campus.
- 2. Facilities and infrastructure factors, as social factors, tend to have less significant effects on students' legal aspirations regarding the rules prohibiting sexual violence on campus. Communication factors and motivation factors as personal factors have a positive effect on students' legal aspirations regarding the rules prohibiting sexual violence on campus. This means that the better the communication and the higher the motivation, the higher the legal aspirations of students towards the rules prohibiting sexual violence.

## **B.** Suggestions

The results showed that the level of legal aspirations of students towards the rules prohibiting sexual violence was moderate; therefore, to increase students' legal aspirations towards the rules prohibiting sexual violence on campus, law faculty students should participate in the socialization of the prevention and handling of sexual violence, read and understand the Sexual Violence Prevention and Handling handbook provided by the Jenderal Soedirman University Sexual Violence Prevention and Handling Task Force, dare to report if there are cases of sexual violence that occur in their environment. As for the institution of Jenderal Soedirman University, it is expected to improve prevention, handling, mechanisms to be more effective, and be able to provide sanctions that provide a deterrent effect, as well as for the facilities and infrastructure available to pay more attention to existing facilities so that they are free from cases of sexual violence.
