CHAPTER V. CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

A. Conclusion

Based on the result, the conclusion is:

- Description of respondent characteristic are as follow: Majority of the respondent in this study are mother (78.4%), most respondent lived in urban village area (98%), and majority have Islamic religion (98%). Respondent last education is higher in the university level (33.3%). Respondent income group slightly higher (51%) on more than minimum regional wage. Majority of the respondent are parent with age ≥35 years (92.2%), while adolescent age slightly higher in the group of age 15-19 years old (52.9%). Parent who has adolescent with slow learner are the most frequent group in this study (29.4%).
- 2. Respondent knowledge about sexual education have major result in moderate group (66%).
- 3. Respondent perception about sexual education is positive as the major group (58.8%).
- 4. The relationship of independent variable and dependent variable result are only 1 variable out of 7 independent variable that have significant relationship, which is *knowledge* (p=0.007). This means factor knowledge are one of the factors that influence parent perception on delivering sexual education for adolescent with disabilities. For variable gender (p=1.000), location of living (p=0.412), religion (p=1.000), income (p=0.461), education (p=0.070), types of adolescent disabilities (p=0.461) do not have significant relationship with parent perception about sexual education.
- 5. Theres is no dominant factors in this research, as in the multivariate analysis there is no independent variable that has significant value p<0.05 parent knowledge (p=0.999), parent education (p=0.297).

B. Suggestion

Based on the research result, suggestion that researcher give as recommendation to increase parent perception about sexual education are as follow

1. For educational institution

For the educational institution it can give sexual education knowledge for parent, in order to make them have good understanding and information about sexual education for adolescent with disabilities. By giving stimulus of information and comprehensive approach it can help parent to have positive perception regarding sexual education, and in return they are not hesitate to provide sexual education for the adolescent.

2. For health care provider

It highlights the important of sexual knowledge to shape positive perception of parent about sexual education. health promotion about sexual education can be given to parent in order to make them ready and be prepared when they children enter adolescent

3. For future researcher

Can involve more about intervention that can improve parent knowledge about sexual education and its impact on parent perception, involve more comprehensive study that can determine parent knowledge and how it affect parent perception.
