

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter presents the conclusions which summarize the finding discussed from the preseding chapter. Additionally, it offers a few suggestion for teachers, students, and other researchers.

5.1 Conclusion

As mentioned in the previous chapter, this research discusses how students can use the Natural Reader Application to improve their skills to pronounce words in English correctly

A pre- experimental design was used in this research on Grade 9B consisted of 23 students at SMP PGRI 1 Ajibarang. From the research analysis in the previous chapter, the conclusion was presented:

1. Based on the research results in previous chapter, the students' pronunciation skills using Natural Reader Application significantly improved. The result was the significance values was $0.002 < 0.05$. As a result, the alternative Hypothesis (H_a) was accepted and the Null Hypothesis (H_o) was rejected, it can be said that there was improvement on the students' pronunciation skills using Natural Readers at SMP PGRI Ajibarang in the Academic year of 2023/2024. It was proven on the mean score of pre-test was 36.2 and the mean score of post-test was 77.3. Therefore, the students mean score of pronunciation was improved 11.3 % from mean score of pre-test and post-test.

2. The use of Natural Readers Application for students' pronunciation skills was fairly effective. It can be seen from gain value calculation. From the data obtained it showed that gain score was 0.58 and it was included in the medium category of gain score. Meanwhile, the percentage of gain score was 58% and it was included in the fairly effective criteria. Therefore, the used of Natural Reader Application is fairly effective for students' pronunciation skills.

5.2 Suggestion

1) For teachers

Based on the results of this research, the use of Natural Reader application can be said to be able to improve students' pronunciation skills. Thus, English teachers can use media to increase learning innovation and help students in the learning process, especially regarding pronunciation in English.

2) For students

Students should practice more pronunciation skill to improve their abilities and increase how to communicate with others.

3) For other researchers

The other researchers can use this research as reference to complete their thesis, and continue it using true experimental research.
