

## SUMMARY

The West Java Provincial Government has built a lot of infrastructure. This development is intended to facilitate economic turnover from within and outside the West Java region. The core of the problem in this study is that the Gross Regional Domestic Product (GRDP) of Bekasi Regency from 2013 to 2020 tends to be unstable, which is known through data from the Central Statistics Agency of Bekasi Regency.

The purpose of this study is to analyze the influence of road infrastructure, education infrastructure, and health infrastructure on Gross Regional Domestic Product (GRDP). This research was conducted in Bekasi Regency. This study uses sub-districts in Bekasi district. The data used in this study is secondary data sourced from the Central Statistics Agency. The number of data in this study is 138 from 23 sub-districts. The analysis technique used in this study is panel data regression.

The results of this study show that road infrastructure and health infrastructure have a positive effect on the Gross Regional Domestic Product (GRDP), while education infrastructure has a negative effect on the Gross Regional Domestic Product (GRDP). The implication of this study is that this research can be considered by the government in formulating policies, especially in order to achieve a sustainable Gross Regional Domestic Product (GRDP). It is important to develop policies and strategies that pay attention to efficiency in building good and sustainable infrastructure in the long term.
