A. Conclusion

Based on the above research, the author can conclude as follows:

1. The arrangement of legal protection for beggars, homeless people, and displaced people in realizing social welfare in the structure of Indonesian legislation in general has shown a level of vertical synchronization because there is harmony between laws and regulations. This means that the legal protection regulations for PGOT with a lower degree are based on regulations that have a higher degree and regulations that have a higher degree are the basis for the formation of regulations with a lower degree. This is evidenced by Banyumas Regency Regional Regulation Number 14 of 2020 concerning Amendments to Banyumas Regency Regional Regulation Number 16 of 2015 concerning Community Disease Management, West Kalimantan Province Sanggau Regency Regional Regulation Number 9 of 2019 concerning the Management of Beggars, Homeless and Abandoned People, Klaten Regency Regional Regulation Number 3 of 2018 concerning the Management of Homeless and Beggars, Government Regulation No. 31 of 1980 concerning the Handling of Homeless and Beggars, Government Regulation No. 39 of 2012 concerning the Implementation of Social

Welfare, Law No. 11 of 2009 concerning Social Welfare, Constitution of the Republic of Indonesia in 1945. Therefore, it can be concluded that all of these regulations are guided by the 1945 State Law of the Republic of Indonesia.

2. Forms of legal protection for beggars, homeless people, and displaced people in realizing social welfare include: guarantees of arrangements to obtain preventive treatment; guarantee that the arrangement will be handled repressively; guarantee of arrangements to obtain rehabilitation treatment; guarantee that the arrangement will receive further guidance handling; guarantee of obtaining treatment through social reintegration; guarantee of arrangements to obtain treatment in social rehabilitation; guarantee of arrangement to obtain treatment through social security; guarantee of arrangements to obtain handling in social empowerment; guarantee of arrangements to receive social protection treatment; Guarantee of arrangement to receive treatment through social assistance.

B. Suggestion

Based on the results of the above research, the suggestion that can be given by the author is that the Government is expected to revise Government Regulation Number 31 of 1980 concerning Homeless and Beggars, namely by regulating social welfare rights for PGOT as regulated in Government Regulation Number 39 of 2012 concerning the

Implementation of Social Welfare and Law Number 11 of 2009 concerning Social Welfare.
