CHAPTER V CLOSING

A. Conclusion

Based on the results of research on factors related to community participation in the waste bank program in Jatiasih Bekasi, it is known that there is a significant relationship between knowledge, having a household member, and household income with the level of community participation. While the variables of education level, and the number of family members are not significantly related to community participation in the waste bank program. This study uses a cross-sectional study design that only describes the variables studied, both on the independent and dependent variables based on observations at one time so that it cannot see a causal relationship. Community participation in waste management at the Waste Bank is currently still low, because many people themselves still do not know what the Waste Bank is and what the system is like.

B. Advice

Some suggestions that can be outlined based on the conclusions include, first, fostering and increasing proactive attitudes and tending to care from each citizen in maintaining and protecting the environment.

Second, at the education level, the cooperation and role of parents and teachers is very necessary and important and must continue to be carried out in an effort to convey information on the process of environmental pollution, the consequences and dangers caused to prevent both repressive and preventive methods; Third, the program to increase awareness and participation of citizens through socialization of the benefits of waste management.
