

CHAPTER V

CLOSING

A. Conclusion

Based on the research results and discussion, the following conclusions can be drawn:

1. The impact of the free trade in sharp weapons through online media on increasing acts of violence among teenagers, has increased significantly. This is due to the ease of online access by teenagers to obtain sharp weapons without adequate legal oversight.
2. response to the free trade in sharp weapons through online media and the rise in violence among youth is being carried out through several integrated efforts. These efforts include:
 - a. Pre-emptive measures in the form of education through the " *Police Goes to School* " program and outreach to students regarding the dangers and legal consequences of misuse of sharp weapons.
 - b. Preventive measures by conducting routine night patrols, raids on students and motor vehicles, and regulating crime-prone areas.
 - c. Repressive efforts through legal processes against perpetrators who are caught, confiscation of sharp weapons, and providing a deterrent effect through the judicial process.

B. Suggestion

1. There needs to be specific regulations and strict oversight of the sale of sharp weapons online. The government needs to implement policies to limit the free online arms trade and limit easy access for teenagers.
2. Increased collaboration between police, schools, and the community in monitoring and mentoring youth. Active involvement from all parties is needed, including early legal education and psychological support to reduce the potential for violence among youth.
