

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

This chapter presents the conclusion and suggestion dealing with the findings of analysis. It presents the summary of the findings that are discussed in the previous chapter and suggestions for the readers.

5.1. Conclusions

Based on the result of the analysis, there are some important points that can be concluded as follows:

1. After analyzing all of the data, the researcher found that there are 67 swearing words used in formal situation of *The Suits* movie series in season 5 episodes 1-10. The types of swearing words found in *The Suits* movie series were categorized into 6 categories. They are animal terms, death terms, excretory terms, religion terms, names of body part and gender related-insult. From the total data of swearing words, they consisted of 2 data for animal terms, 16 data for death terms, 30 data for excretory terms, 10 data for religious terms, 5 data for names of body part, and 4 data for gender related insult. Related to the total number of the data, it can be stated that category of excretory terms is most frequent data in occurrence among others.

2. In analyzing the meaning of swearing words, the researcher should know the context of swearing words usage, so it means that the meaning of swearing words will different based on the context. The meaning that can be interpreted in *The Suits* are **dog** (bad person), **hell** (to show annoyed, surprised and to emphasized), **bullshit** (nonsense or untrue in talk), **piss** (annoyed), **shit** (nonsense, surprised expression, to say in trouble and bad person), **damn** (emphasized something), **goddamn** (expression of anger and to say that is annoyed), **ass** (emphasized all part by mentioning a part of body part), **asshole** (unpleasant or bad person), **son of a bitch** (unpleasant or bad person).
3. After analyzing the meanings of swearing words, the researcher found some interpreted meaning from each swearing word that are used in *The Suits* movie series. Some of them has same meaning. The word **shit** has same meaning with **bullshit** (nonsense), **asshole** has same meaning with **son of a bitch**, **dog** and **shit** (bad person), **hell** has same meaning with **damn** and **ass** (to emphasized statement), **piss** and **goddamn** has same meaning (annoyed).

5.2 Suggestion

After finishing an analysis, the researcher highly expected that this research will be useful and will give some advantages in understanding swearing words. Thus, there are some suggestions for other researchers and readers.

1. For other researchers

The researcher suggest to other researchers who are interested in investigating the same field to have a deeper analysis by using another theories related to swearing words. Besides, it is also suggested to investigating the reason why people use the swearing words.

2. For the readers

For the readers who are interested in this study, they can learn more about the other kinds of swearing words, another theory about types of swearing and meaning of swearing words, so they can make a comparison and they are expected to understand more about the materials.
