

**PERAN *INTERNATIONAL LABOUR ORGANIZATION* (ILO) DALAM MENANGANI
ISU *CHILD LABOUR* DI BANGLADESH TAHUN 2007 – 2015**

ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini mengkaji tentang peran *International Labour Organization* (ILO) dalam menangani kasus *child labour* di Bangladesh pada tahun 2007-2015. Faktor kemiskinan, pendidikan, budaya, serta perlindungan konstitusi/hukum yang lemah menyebabkan jumlah buruh anak di Bangladesh mencapai angka 60%. ILO sebagai organisasi internasional yang menangani masalah perburuhan, turut berkontribusi dalam menanggulangi isu *child labour* melalui beberapa program. Teknik pengumpulan data dilakukan dengan metode skunder menggunakan berbagai sumber literatur. Konsep organisasi internasional digunakan untuk menganalisis dan menjawab pertanyaan penelitian. Hasil dari penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa melalui peran-peran yang telah dilakukan ILO dalam menanggulangi isu *child labour* di Bangladesh, maka ILO telah menjalankan fungsinya sebagai organisasi internasional yang berupa fungsi norma, fungsi pembuatan keputusan, fungsi operasional, serta fungsi sosialisasi.

ABSTRACT

This research examines the role of the International Labor Organization (ILO) in handling child labor cases in Bangladesh in 2007-2015. The factors of poverty, education, culture, and weak constitutional / legal protection have resulted in the number of child laborers in Bangladesh reaching 60%. The ILO as an international organization that deals with labor issues, has also contributed to overcoming child labor issues through several programs. The data collection technique is done by using a secondary method using various literature sources. The concept of international organization is used to analyze and answer research questions. The results of this study indicate that through the roles that the ILO has played in overcoming child labor issues in Bangladesh, the ILO has carried out its function as an international

organization in the form of a norm function, a decision-making function, an operational function, and a socialization function.
