

HUBUNGAN PERSEPSI MAHASISWA JURUSAN KEPERAWATAN DENGAN KEPUTUSAN UNTUK MELANJUTKAN KE TAHAP PROFESI NERS UNIVERSITAS JENDERAL SOEDIRMAN

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ABSTRAK

Latar Belakang: Mahasiswa keperawatan memiliki persepsi tersendiri terhadap proses pendidikan Ners. Hal tersebut kemungkinan akan mempengaruhi mahasiswa untuk mengambil keputusan melanjutkan ke tahap profesi Ners atau tidak. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui hubungan antara persepsi dengan keputusan mahasiswa untuk melanjutkan ke tahap profesi Ners.

Metodologi: Penelitian ini menggunakan metode kuantitatif dengan desain *cross sectional*. Teknik pengambilan sampel menggunakan metode *total sampling*. Besar populasi yaitu 76 responden yang memenuhi kriteria inklusi dan eksklusi. Analisa data menggunakan *Contingency Coefficient*.

Hasil Penelitian: Hasil analisis pada penelitian ini menunjukkan 74 mahasiswa (97,4%) yang memiliki persepsi baik dan terdapat 72 mahasiswa (94,7%) yang termotivasi melanjutkan ke tahap profesi Ners. Hasil tersebut menunjukkan terdapat hubungan persepsi dengan keputusan mahasiswa yang ingin melanjutkan ke tahap profesi Ners ($p=0,004$).

Kesimpulan: Terdapat hubungan persepsi mahasiswa dengan keputusan untuk melanjutkan ke tahap profesi Ners.

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THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN PERCEPTION OF NURSING STUDENTS WITH DECISIONS TO CONTINUE NURSING PROFESSION STAGE IN JENDERAL SOEDIRMAN UNIVERSITY

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ABSTRACT

Background: Nursing students has its own perception of the Ners education process. This possibility of Nursing would affect students for took decisions to continue Nursing profession stage or not. This study aims to determine correlation between perceptions and student decisions to proceed to the stage of the Nursing profession.

Methods: This study used a quantitative method with cross sectional design. This study used total sampling method. The population were 76 respondents who meet the inclusion and exclusion criteria. The data were analyzed using contingency coefficient test.

Results: The results of the analysis in this study showed that 74 students (97.4%) had a good perception and there were 72 students (94.7%) who motivated to continue Nursing profession stage. The result showed that there was a correlation between perception and student decisions to continue Nursing profession stage ($p = 0.004$).

Conclusion: There was a correlation between perceptions and student decisions to continue Nursing profession stage.
